





The Outback Wilderness

Your itinerary becomes anywhere in the Outback Wilderness—an Outback that's heightened, quite literally, with 9.5 inches of ground clearance. Its rugged front bumper cladding and grille, along with Anodized Copper-finish accents, reveal its bold nature, while its capable engineering drives the point home. For more fun while taking on the terrain, the Outback Wilderness is equipped with a further advanced dual-function X-MODE system designed to work at higher speeds. This is combined with off-road-optimized gearing as well as increased approach, departure and breakover angles for tackling a greater variety of surfaces. The Outback Wilderness also has ladder-type roof rails for an increased roof load capacity and comes with additional tow points for greater confidence when heading out.


Blind-Spot Detection

Using radar sensors, Blind-Spot Detection^{1,2} warns you with a visual indicator on your exterior mirror if the system detects a vehicle in your blind spot. Another feature of this system, Lane Change Assist, alerts you with a flashing indicator on your exterior mirror if it senses a vehicle approaching at a higher speed in a neighboring lane and you signal for a lane change.



Rear Cross-Traffic Alert

Rear Cross-Traffic Alert^{1,2} uses radar sensors to help warn you of traffic approaching from the side as you are backing up, utilizing a flashing visual indicator on your exterior mirror and Rear-Vision Camera display as well as an audible warning.





Reverse Automatic Braking

Reverse Automatic Braking^{1,3} can detect objects directly behind your vehicle when backing up at a low speed and can help bring the Outback to a stop should an object be detected within its range and the brakes have yet to be applied. There's also the Rear-Vision Camera to help you keep an eye out.

The Outback features the latest STARLINK® Safety and Security^{1,4} system, which can alert a first responder in an emergency, help police locate your vehicle if it's stolen and more.
